___ Bow loop (Two-inch (5 cm) loop of line out of bow gunwale)

___ 8 m Bow line min 5 mm thick – Tied to mast step, knot free, 26 ft, w/ bowline at the outboard end

___ 2 bailers attached to the boat with a bowline

___ 3 airbags fully inflated – Not leaking and secured properly

___ Rudder Retainer Clip-prevents rudder from popping out

___ Daggerboard with retainer line attached to the hull

___ Mast tie or mast clamp attached to the hull

___ Main Sheet Snap Closed

___ Mainsheet Bridle- No looser than 10 cm from the boom at any point

___ Safety line from the ring in the bridal to the boom-with no tension-

___ Paddle attached to the boat

___ Personal Flotation Device (PFD) with whistle attached by lanyard; PFD must provide adequate flotation for weight of the sailor.
